

Rentokil Pest Control Environmental Policy Statement of Intent

This policy acknowledges the Rentokil Initial plc Environmental policy statement and gives effect to this in Rentokil Pest Control.

Rentokil Pest Control is committed to providing quality services and products by capable and adequately trained and supervised staff, using work procedures which contribute to enhanced protection of the environment. Securing this commitment is recognised as an important objective which contributes to business performance.

Rentokil Pest Control is further committed:

- to an Environmental Management System which employs the Rentokil Initial plc Good Practice Procedures designated for Rentokil Pest Control activities and through these, to set appropriate environmental objectives and report on the results of monitoring and reviews of environmental performance,
- to co-operate with our suppliers and with our customers and their other contractors and site visitors, to ensure good environmental practices,
- to communicate and consult appropriately with staff, in order to encourage good environmental practices and to develop improvements,
- to provide staff with information, instruction, training and supervision so that they can recognise their responsibilities for complying with the environmental procedures and arrangements detailed in the Good Practice Procedures and in their appropriate technical and procedural manuals. They are also asked to report to their managers, any matter they would reasonably consider represented a shortcoming in Rentokil Pest Control's environmental management arrangements.
- to comply with environmental legislation.

The Managing Director will provide appropriate financial and physical resources to maintain this policy through the arrangements which are detailed in the Good Practice Procedures.

These arrangements include the procedures for monitoring, reviewing and reporting environmental performance, for ensuring compliance with legislation and for developing progressive improvements in environmental performance.

The Environmental Policy will be reviewed regularly and at other times as may be necessary, by the Managing Director and Health, Safety and Environment Manager. Revisions will be appropriately issued.
